MILAN - C.L.A.S.S., the eco-fashion network with showrooms in Milan, London and New York has formed a new partnership with Italian yarn manufacturer Filature Miroglio, part of the Miroglio Textile Group.



Part of C.L.A.S.S.'s remit is to bring sustainable innovations to the forefront of commercial and retail fashion and its partnership with Filature Miroglio has been created to promote the polyester filament and spun yarn producer's Newlife family of products.

Newlife yarns are made of recycled polyester which is 100% derived from the post-consumer PET waste such as plastic bottles. Earlier this year, the company said it aimed to convert its whole range of virgin PET yarns to its Newlife brand by 2015.

"The exclusivity of the technology used in the creation of Newlife springs from the systemic approach which makes possible the collection of the bottles, their selection and their transformation into a polymer suitable for spinning by using a mechanical - not chemical - process," Miroglio says. "Vast quantities of PET, otherwise destined for a waste disposal site, get a "new life" in innovative and responsible multipurpose products. This is Filature Miroglio's first step towards its final goal: by 2015 the company aims at converting its range of virgin PET yarns in Newlife yarns."

C.L.A.S.S. is a global network that aims to promote and safeguard the ethical and aesthetical side of business, with particular attention paid to the values of eco-sustainability across a wide range of eco-textiles, yarns, processes, finished products and services.
